



**TOWN OF NEW GLASGOW  
SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT  
COMMUNITY RECREATION COORDINATOR**

The Town of New Glasgow Department of Community Development is accepting applications from youth aged 15-30 to develop, facilitate and assist with recreation programming during the summer months. Enrollment in a post-secondary institution is not required; however, priority will be given to individuals enrolled at a post-secondary institution during the 2022-23 school year.

Applicants must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment; have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial legislation and regulations. The term is 15 weeks beginning on May 16, 2021.

This position is recreation focused; however, the Community Recreation Coordinator may assist with other projects within the Town of New Glasgow's Department of Community Development. Duties include developing and facilitating recreational initiatives for all ages, supervising and leading participants through activities, preparing daily and weekly plans, evaluating activities, partnering with community organizations, and working with the Department of Community Development on a variety of programs. The Community Recreation Coordinator will act as an ambassador of the Town of New Glasgow while interacting with the public, program participants and their families.
