## By-Law No. 31 Respecting certain exemptions from the Fire Protection Rate

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of New Glasgow, under the authority of s. 80(2) of the *Municipal Government Act* of the Province of Nova Scotia, S.N.S., 1998 c.18 as amended as follows:

- 1. This By-Law shall be known as By-Law No. 31 and may be cited as the "Fire Protection Rate Exemption By-Law".
- 2. In this By-Law, "Church" or "Churches" means any place or places of worship and the land used in conjunction therewith, and every Churchyard and Church burial ground and every Church hall used for religious or congregational purposes exclusively save only for occasions specifically authorized by Church authorities, but shall not include a glebe house or manse or ecclesiastical residence associated with any Church.
- 3. The Council of the Town of New Glasgow is of the opinion that the Churches in the Town of New Glasgow provide a valuable service to the Town that might otherwise not be provided and therefore the property of the Churches as defined herein shall not be subject to the fire protection rate and shall be exempt from the fire protection rate of the Town of New Glasgow pursuant to s. 80(2) of the *Municipal Government Act*, SNS, 1998 c.18 as amended.
- 4. Continued exemption under this By-Law is subject to compliance with annual requests confirming the charitable status of each Church hereby exempted.
- 5. The effective date of this By-Law is June 23, 2006.
