Prostate Cancer Awareness Month
September 2026

WHEREAS, prostate cancer is the most common cancer to affect Canadian men; and

WHEREAS, 1 in 8 Canadian men will be diagnosed with the disease in his lifetime; and

WHEREAS, the survival rate for prostate cancer can be close to 100% when detected early; and

WHEREAS, those with a family history of the disease, or those of African or Caribbean descent, are at a greater risk of developing prostate cancer; and

WHEREAS, Prostate Cancer Canada recommends that men get a PSA test in their 40's to establish their baseline; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, I, Mayor Nancy Dicks, do hereby proclaim September 2026, as “**Prostate Cancer Awareness Month**” in the Town of New Glasgow.
