To apply, submit your resume and cover letter to policecareers@newglasgow.ca with copies of your birth certificate, driver's license, and certificate from a recognized police training program.

Minimum requirements to be a police officer in New Glasgow

You must meet the definition of a police officer as defined by the Nova Scotia Police Act and the Nova Scotia Department of Justice guidelines. Minimum requirements include the following:

- An applicant who successfully completed an approved police recruiting training program from a recognized training institution within the last 24 months, or an experienced police officer currently serving or has served within the past two years with a police service in Canada
- A Canadian military police officer (regular service) with qualifications Level 5
- 19 years of age by the application deadline
- Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- Grade 12 education
- No criminal convictions for which a pardon has not been granted and no adult criminal charges pending
- Must possess and maintain a valid Class 5 Nova Scotia driver's license or equivalent from another Canadian province

- Medical requirements - Candidates must be medically fit
- Driver's abstract - Indicating an acceptable driving record
- CPR & First Aid - Current Standard Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (C.P.R.) Level C
- Reference letters - Three letters of reference of which one must be a work reference.
