About the Student Navigator role

We are thrilled to offer a post-secondary student with a passion for healthcare this unique opportunity to share their knowledge and experience, working with local healthcare providers, students and prospective healthcare students through this important community work.

Activities and responsibilities

Reporting to the Project Navigator, the role would be on a full-time basis and working on executing activities and efforts under the three strategic pillars of Healthy Pictou County. At the on-set of your employment, the Project Navigator would work with you on goals for your placement and key projects and objectives, suited to your background and the work required in the organization.

In the role you would have the opportunity to bring your passion for healthcare to connect with local students and prospective healthcare students to determine their needs and inform the materials and efforts for students, including promotional materials, resources and guides, events, and networking. A key focus of the role would be executing the activities successfully applied for in our recent [Office of Healthcare Professionals Recruitment Funding](#) which includes virtual reality video work (opportunity to support showcasing our community and healthcare facilities), retention efforts (peer recognition activities, networking events, social events), and supporting cultural training for our recruitment committee and stakeholders.

The position may also allow for participation in site visits with prospective physicians and their families, and the opportunity to meet people from all over the world and share more about our community and its offerings.
