1. **Bid Sheet, Part 'A' (Approaches and Downtown)**

Clarification to the scope of work required on Spreader Patching this will primarily be completed on East River Rd. there are several patches within 3-4 blocks along East River Rd. The intention is to have all of these locations milled out and ready for asphalt so they can all be paved consecutively once started.

2. **Item #18**

Clarification on Item #18 the work is to include just the labour, equipment, material and traffic control required to install asphalt. All excavation, hole preparation work, gravels, etc. needed to get the location ready for asphalt installation will be completed by the Town.

3. **Bid Sheet, Milling (Provisional)**

Clarification to the scope of work required on Milling (Provisional) this line item will require the contractor to provide a cost per m² for all labour, equipment, materials to complete milling as per the depths detailed in the bid sheet documents. The Town will provide the traffic control, and work will have 1 primary location, East River Rd. at several locations on East River Rd. all milling to be completed on this street consecutively once started.

4. Bid Sheet, Page 5 of 6

Replace the current bid sheet Page 5 of 6 with the enclosed bid sheet which clarified Part "F" (Provisional) Milling units are in "m²".

The MABRP will be the weighted average posted rack price established for the month, based on the rack prices provided by each approved supplier.
