

**TOWN OF NEW GLASGOW**  
**TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**  
**MONDAY, AUGUST 19, 2019**

A regular meeting of New Glasgow Town Council was held on Monday, August 19, 2019 at 5:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Present were: Mayor Dicks; Deputy Mayor Guthro, Councillors Dorrington, Lewis; Fraser and MacDonald. Also present were: Lisa MacDonald, CAO; Corey Smith, Director of Corporate Services; GERALYN MacDonald, Director of Community Economic Development; Kelly Sloan, Executive Assistant; Frank DeMont, Solicitor; Rachel Mitchell, Climate Change Co-ordinator; Cindy MacKinnon from DEANS. Absent from the meeting was Councillor Proudfoot and Earl MacKenzie, Town Engineer.

Mayor Dicks introduced Rachel Mitchell who has been hired recently as our Climate Change Co-ordinator. She was hired under a Federal Funding grant for a 2 year project and will be focusing on three main things; 1. Partners for Climate Protection 2. Climate Adaptation Plan 3. Greenhouse gas emissions and reductions.

Mayor Dicks noted the events she attended over the past month: the Festival of the Tartan events which was relocated to the Parkdale field this year which was a success; the Glen Haven Tea as well as the Loch Broom Log Church service and Golf Tournament; the unveiling of the Reverend George Munroe Grant panel in Stellarton; the 18<sup>th</sup> Race on the River Event where the Women Alike Abreast a River team celebrated its 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

Deputy Mayor Guthro stated that he welcomed the teams to the Race on the River at the Opening Ceremony who were visiting from all over Atlantic Canada and the

USA. He noted that the local Women Alike Dragonboat team will be inducted into the Pictou County Sports Heritage Hall of Fame. He also attended the Glen Haven Tea and the Family Fun Nighty.

The Mayor also highlighted the Centre for Entrepreneurship and Education Development (CEED) Camp and Sale at the former Roseland Theatre; the Mayor's Tea at the Carmichael Stewart House Museum; the announcement of the Federal/Provincial funding for the Hemlock Group Trenton Park Revitalization project; the book launch attended by Deputy Mayor Guthro and Councillor Dorrington for Judge Clyde MacDonald's 16<sup>th</sup> book which has a chapter on Courtney Malcolm; the Pictou County Seniors Festival in Trenton; the opening of Boston Pizza and Dinner on the River organized by the Farmer's Market.
