

**TOWN OF NEW GLASGOW**  
**TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**  
**MONDAY, AUGUST 15, 2022**

A regular meeting of New Glasgow Town Council was held on Monday, August 15, 2022, at 5:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Present were: Mayor Dicks; Deputy Mayor Dorrington, Peters, Fraser, El-Haddad, and MacDonald. Also present were: Lisa MacDonald, CAO; Earl MacKenzie, Director of Engineering and Public Works; Ross White, Director of Fire, Inspection and Emergency Services; Rachel Mitchell, Climate Change and Sustainability Manager; Kelly Sloan, Executive Assistant; Cindy Thompson, NSCC graduate on work term; and Frank DeMont, Solicitor. Present using Microsoft Teams were Councillor Borden and Corey Smith, Director of Corporate Services. Absent from the meeting was Peter Douthwright, Director of Community Development and scheduled presenter, Lindsay Corbin, NS Coalition for Healthy School Food.
