

**TOWN OF NEW GLASGOW**  
**TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**  
**MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2023**

A regular meeting of New Glasgow Town Council was held on Monday, September 18, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Present were: Mayor Dicks; Deputy Mayor Peters; Councillors Dorrington, Fraser, El-Haddad, and MacDonald. Also present were: Lisa MacDonald, CAO; Earl MacKenzie, Director of Engineering and Public Works; Peter Douthwright, Director of Community Development; Police Chief Chisholm; Deputy Police Chief Leil; Constable MacDonald; Ross White, Director of Fire, Inspection and Emergency Services; Kelly Sloan, Executive Assistant and Frank DeMont, Solicitor.
